



EXTERNSHIP INFORMATION - PET POISON HELPLINE

- Pet Poison Helpline, a 24/7 animal poison control center based near Minneapolis, MN, accepts externship applications from 3rd and 4th year veterinary students registered in AVMA accredited veterinary schools.
- We will accept students for 1 or 2-week block rotations only, with a maximum of 10 externs/year.
- Rotation hours are typically 8 am – 5 pm, Monday – Friday. No weekend or night shifts are required, though some evening shifts are highly encouraged in order to experience a variety of cases.
- A confidentiality agreement must be signed at the start of the externship. All material is proprietary, and no electronic or hard copies may be removed from the premises.
- Dress is generally casual, except for occasional days when client visitors are present, and business casual attire is required (you will be informed of this prior to the day, if applicable).
- No equipment is necessary.
- There are NO tuition costs.
- Housing is not provided, and all expenses are the responsibility of the student.
- On-site parking is available at no cost.
- There is a cafeteria in the building with breakfast, lunch, and snack items for purchase.
